Description of Camp

Camp Hollywoodland is located in Griffith Park, nestled in a canyon between the Hollywood Sign and the Griffith Park Observatory. Run by the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks, the camp was designed to provide camping and recreational programs for children. The facility includes 10 cabins (each sleep 20 people), rest rooms, showers, a craft room, ceramic studio, dance studio, adventure challenge course (including a climbing wall, high and low ropes course), swimming pool, archery range, campfire ring, hiking trails and a main lodge and dining facility.

Campers arrive on Monday morning and go home Saturday morning. The week is filled with theme-based activities and every-day camp activities which will include: swimming, arts and crafts, sports, games, ceramics, outdoor cooking and much more. Once a week the entire camp goes on a weekly field trip to amusement parks and venues throughout southern California.

The Campers

Camp Hollywoodland provides outdoor recreational programs for girls between the ages of 6-17. We provide low cost overnight camping experiences to campers from the greater Los Angeles Area. Our campers come from a wide variety of ethnic and economic backgrounds and our diversity is one of the greatest features. The cross-cultural understanding, leadership and communications between campers and staff is the back bone of everyday life here at camp.

Desired Qualifications

- Female at least 18 years of age.
- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Current First Aid and CPR certifications from American Red Cross or American Heart Association.
- Some paid or volunteer experience working with children is desired but not mandatory.
- Desire and ability to work with children.
- Ability to relate to one's peer group.
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance.
- Ability to assist in teaching activities.
- Good character, integrity, judgement and adaptability.
- Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control.
- Ability to live and work in a community environment.

General Responsibilities

- Supervise children in an all day and overnight environment.
- To identify and meet camper needs.
- To carry out Camp programs.
- To fulfill other staff administrative roles, specific responsibilities will be discussed at your interview and during staff training.
- Staff is required to work a minimum of 7 weeks during our summer sessions. Camp runs from June 25 - August 25, 2007

Selection Process

2. Make an appointment for an interview. There are two to three interviews involved in the selection process. If you are selected as a counselor you will be notified within two weeks.

Hiring

- Once selected, you must fill out an official City of Los Angeles hiring application and be fingerprinted at an official City of Los Angeles Fingerprinting Facility .

Training

- **Mandatory** paid staff training will take place June 18 - 22, 2007

Salary

- First year counselors usually start at \$400.00 per week.
- In addition to a paid salary you will also receive meals, lodging Monday thru Saturday morning, staff shirts, and free admission to various amusement parks.
